Terms of commitment: The Materials Characterization Lab Internship is an *unpaid opportunity*. The work schedule is flexible, but interns are be required to work a minimum of 5-10 hours per week. All attendance will take place during the hours of 9 AM to 5 PM, Monday through Friday.

To have an internship fulfill a Section 3 - Technical Elective requirement, students must earn a total of 3 credit hours and complete a graded Technical Report. Students must complete two semesters at a part-time internship to receive Tech Elective credit. *Students are responsible for paying for the credit hours associated with the 3 credit hours required for Technical Elective requirement.* Usually students will register for MSE 5800 for 1.0 credit in the Fall Semester and for MSE 5801 for 2.0 credits in the Spring Semester. The internship progress will be monitored, evaluated, and graded by the Internship Program Advisor.
